## Day 01

Singapore – Nagoya – Gujo Hachiman

(- / L / D)

Hotel: Hotel Gujo Hachiman or similar (Hot Spring)

- **Gujo Hachiman:** Known for its charming and pristine waterways, this town sits in a valley where three rivers converge. In winter, local indigo dyers use the rivers' cold, clean, fast running water to fix the colourful natural dyes.
- **Food Sample making experience:** Food sample is another thing that Gujo Hachiman is famous for. As a producer of around 80% of all the food replicas in Japan, this is the best place to try your hands at some food sample making!

## Day 02

Gujo Hachiman – Takayama (B / L / D)

Hotel: Hotel Associa Takayama Resort or similar (Hot Spring)

- **Shirakawa Village:** Designated in 1995 as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the village is made up of over 100 gassho-zukuri structures nestled in a picturesque valley. Specially constructed to withstand deep snowfalls, these structures have roofs that reach 9m. A visit here is an encounter with a Japan from long ago.
- **Matsuri no Mori:** The Takayama Festival is one of Japan's top three most beautiful festivals. Eleven elaborate and exquisitely-created festival floats, a third of their original size but even more intricate, used in the Autumn Festival are on magnificent display here in Japan's first underground structure.
- **Takayama Jinya:** Take a step back in time over at the only remaining local government office that was in use since the Edo Period, when Takayama was under direct control of the Tokugawa Shogunate.

## Day 03

Takayama – Okuhida (B / L / D)

Hotel: Hodakaso Sangetsu or similar (Hot Spring)

- **Takayama Morning Market:** Every morning from 7am to midday, farmers from surrounding villages bring fresh produce to the market. With varieties that change based on the season you can enjoy a leisurely stroll along this charming street.
- **Hida limestone cave:** Opening up 800 meters below

a beautiful waterfall, the Hida Great Limestone Cave is the only place where you can see delicate finger-like helictite cave formations.

- **Shin-Hotaka Ropeway:** Soaring up 2,156m to two-thirds of Mt Hotaka (Japan's third tallest mountain) is the ropeway that has garnered a prestigious 2-star award in the Michelin Guidebook.

## Day 04

Okuhida – Matsumoto (B / L / D)

Hotel: Hotel Buena Vista Matsumoto or similar

- **Daio Wasabi Farm:** Spreading across 15 hectares, and with pure spring water that emerges from bottom of the Japan Alps, this is Japan's biggest wasabi farm, producing 15 tonnes of wasabi yearly. Be sure to give the wasabi ice cream and chocolate here a try!
- **Matsumoto Castle:** A National Treasure of Japan and the oldest existing castle in Japan, this is one of Japan's finest historic castles located at the gateway to the Japan Alps.
- **Other places:** Strolling along Nawate Street

## Day 05

Matsumoto – Nagoya (B / L / D)

Hotel: Nagoya Marriott Associa Hotel or similar

- **Strawberry Picking:** A great way to commune with nature and literally enjoy the fruits of your labour!
- **Magome-juku:** Nestled deep in the mountains, this post town has been restored to its former glory on Nakasendo, an ancient road that linked Kyoto to Edo during the Edo period.
