Day 01

Singapore – Nagoya – Chitose – Noboribetsu

Hotel: *Noboribetsu Sekisuitei or similar (Meal on Board / - / D)*

- **Bibi Steak Restaurant** Savour one of Hokkaido's Best Wagyu beef at this charming log-cabin styled restaurant.
- **Noboribetsu:** Feel the ultimate relaxation at Hokkaido's most famous hot spring. This is where you can soak to your heart's content amidst Hokkaido's brilliant autumn foliage.
- Other place:** Lake Shikotsu; Wagyu Beef Bibi Steakhouse, Chitose Rera Outlet Mall

Day 02

Noboribetsu – Hakodate

Hotel: *Yunokawa Hanabishi (Hot spring) or similar (B / - / D)*

- **Hakodate Kosetsuen:** Created since the late Meiji era, this Japanese garden was designated as one of Japan's "Places of Scenic Beauty" in 2001. In autumn, the trees turn into a dazzling display of vibrant colours.
- **Hakodate Ropeway:** A ropeway of 334 metres to Mt Hakodate's summit. See one of the top three night views in the world where stars seem to have fallen onto earth as they contrast with the inky black of the Tsugaru Straits.
- Other places:** Onuma Quasi-National Park, Trappistine Convent

Day 03

Hakodate

Hotel: *Yunokawa Hanabishi (Hot spring) or similar (B / - / D)*

- **Hakodate Morning Market:** A marketplace of around 150 shops selling some of the freshest seafood caught off Hokkaido's shores and located in a city that boasts of one of Hokkaido's most abundant fish hauls.
- **Motomachi Sightseeing:** In 1854, Hakodate was designated one of the first treaty ports in Japan, where Japan was open to foreign influence. Many of the original buildings remain today in this charming neighborhood of steep slopes, as a legacy of the treaty-port status.
- Other places:** Motomachi Sightseeing, Kanemori Red Brick Warehouse

Day 04

Hakodate – Rusutsu

Hotel: *Rusutsu Resort (Hot spring) or similar (B / - / D)*

- **Mt Usu Ropeway:** A Ropeway to the magnificent views of one of Japan's most active volcanoes – Mt Usu and the surrounding craters from an elevation of 356m.

- **Silo Observatory:** The centrepiece of the G8 Summit in 2008 – Lake Toya – is presented at its most beautiful here from this observation point, where cobalt-blue water meets mountains that have donned their autumn mantle.

- **Other places:** Mt Showa, Lake Hill Farm

Day 5

Rusutsu – Otaru

Hotel: *Grand Park Otaru or similar (B / - / -)*

- **Shinsen Numa:** Believed to be home to the gods, the tranquility and beauty of this marshland amidst the Niseko Mountains is made magical by the autumn foliage.
- **Shakotan Peninsular:** This rugged and spectacularly scenic coastline rises over 100m high from the surrounding Sea of Japan.
- Other places:** Niseko Panorama Line, Fukidashi Park, Cape Kamui

Day 6

Otaru – Sapporo

Hotel: *Sapporo Grand Hotel or similar (B / - / -)*

- **Otaru:** Once a flourishing seaport and the "Wall Street of the North", Otaru is a stretch of lovingly restored warehouses that include one of the biggest music box museums in the world, confectionaries, dessert and exquisite glass shops.
- **Ishiya Chocolate Factory:** The birthplace of the most famous chocolate in Hokkaido – Shiroy Koibito (White Lover's Chocolate). Prepared to be charmed by the European-styled buildings and utterly spoiled by the choices of delicious sweets.
- Other places:** Otaru Canal, Sapporo Clock Tower, Old Hokkaido Government Building, Odori Park

Day 7

Sapporo

Hotel: *Sapporo Grand Hotel or similar (B / - / -)*

- **Mitsui Outlet Park Kita-Hiroshima:** A shopping haven comprising 128 popular name brands. You can also find fresh food, local produce, electronics, well-loved local and international brands.
- **Sapporo:** Explore the heart of Hokkaido from an early morning visit to the Sapporo Curb Market for a spot of fresh seafood to a mouth-watering bowl of ramen late at night in Susukino's Ramen Alley; from immersing yourself in Hokkaido's history at the Old Hokkaido Government Building to being totally spoilt for choice in the myriad of stores above and underground in Sapporo, it will be a day truly well spent.
