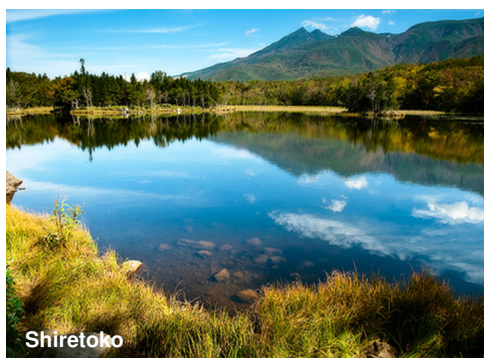

Day 01

Singapore – Tokyo/Nagoya – Asahikawa (- /L/D)

Hotel: Asahikawa Grand Hotel or similar

- **Asahikawa Ramen Village:** Sink your teeth into mouthwatering ramen from the chain of Hokkaido's favorite ramen shops.
- **Otokoyama Sake Brewery:** Home to one of the world's most renowned sake brands – Otokoyama Sake, a winner of 33 consecutive years of gold medal in the Overseas Wine and Spirit Competition. Experience sake-making history that is more than three centuries old.

Day 02

Asahikawa – Saroma (B/L/D)

Hotel: Lake Saroma Tsuruga Resort (Hotspring) or similar

- **Ginga and Ryusei Waterfalls:** Two of Japan's most beautiful waterfalls come together in a spectacular display of contrasts. The graceful flow of Ginga ("Milky Way") is juxtaposed perfectly with the power of the Ryusei ("Shooting Stars"), while the brilliance of autumn is complemented by clear blue skies and the austere grey cliffs.
 - **Kurodake Ropeway:** A 7-minute ride up to the 7th station of Mt Kurodake at 1,984m above sea level. Be captivated by the canopy of golden yellow birch trees, crisp greens pines and crimson red mountain ash.
- Other places:** Wakka Wild Flower Park

Day 03

Saroma – Shiretoko (B/L/D)

Hotel: Shiretoko Grand Hotel (Hotspring) or similar

- **Okhotsk Drift Ice Museum:** Drift ice is symbolic of winter in the Okhotsk region. A room kept at an unimaginably-freezing temperature of -18 degrees all year round lets you can enjoy winter even in autumn!
 - **Shiretoko Five Lakes:** Looking like a god's handprint, these serene waters that mirror the spectacular autumn foliage of the Shiretoko mountain range create a paradise that weaves its magic on all its visitors.
 - **Oshinkoshin Waterfalls:** Ranked as one of Japan's top 100 waterfalls, this waterfall is made even more beautiful framed by autumn foliage.
- Other places:** Lake Noto, Mt Tendo,

Day 04

Shiretoko – Akan (B /L/D)

Hotel: Akan no Mori Tsuruga Resort Hanayuuka (Hotspring) or similar

- **Shiretoko Cruise:** One of the best ways to explore this wild untamed heart of Hokkaido. Named Shiretoko ("the end of the earth") by Hokkaido's indigenous people, the Ainu, this UNESCO World Heritage site is also home to Japan's biggest population of brown bears.

- **Ainu Kotan Village:** The largest Ainu community in Hokkaido and home to around 200 people with Ainu ancestry. Catch a glimpse of their lifestyle through folk art, traditional dances and architecture.

Other places: Mt Io, Lake Mashu

Day 05

Akan – Tokachigawa (B/L/D)

Hotel: Tokachigawa Daiichi Hotel (Hotspring) or similar

- **Lake Onneto:** Every autumn, the colored foliage of the trees vies with the gorgeous ever-changing colours of Lake Onneto's waters for which is the most breath-taking.
 - **Tokachi Millennium Garden:** Designed by Britain's leading garden designer, Mr Dan Pearson, this sprawling garden is a perfect testament to the beauty created when Nature's handiwork and Man's environmental consciousness intertwine.
- Other places:** Lake Shikaribetsu, Ryugetsu Sweetpia Garden, Tokachi Hanabatake Farm

Day 06

Tokachigawa – Sapporo (B/L/D)

Hotel: Sapporo Grand Hotel or similar

- **Sahoro Bear Mountain:** Home to 18 Hokkaido Brown bears; spot them splashing playfully in the water or dozing in the shade of the trees.
 - **Otaru:** Once a flourishing seaport and the "Wall Street of the North", Otaru is a stretch of lovingly restored warehouses that include one of the biggest music box museums in the world, confectionaries, dessert and exquisite glass shops.
- Other places:** Otaru Canal, Kitaichi Glassware Shop, Music Box Museum

Day 07

Free day in Sapporo (B/-/-)

Hotel: Sapporo Grand Hotel or similar

- **Free day in Sapporo:** The heart of Hokkaido is best explored from an early morning visit to Sapporo Curb Market for fresh seafood followed by a history tour at the Old Hokkaido Government Building and underground shopping and last but definitely not least, late night supper at Susukino's Ramen Alley.

Day 8

Sapporo – Chitose – Tokyo – Singapore (B/-/-)
