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## Day 01

### Singapore – Tokyo/Nagoya – Asahikawa

Hotel: *Asahikawa Grand or similar (Meal on Board / - / D)*

- **Asahikawa Ramen Village** Houses 8 of Hokkaido's favorite ramen shops where you will be greeted by the mouthwatering fragrance of ramen and merry slurping sounds of people enjoying their ramen every time the restaurants' doors open.
- **Otokoyama Sake Brewery** Home to one of the world's most renowned sake brands – Otokoyama Sake, a winner of 33 consecutive years of gold medal in the Overseas Wine and Spirit Competition. Experience sake-making history that is more than three centuries old here.

## Day 02

### Asahikawa - Abashiri

Hotel: *Abashiri koso (Hot spring) or similar (B / - / D)*

- **Kurodake Ropeway** After a 7-minute ride up to the 7th station of Mt Kurodake at 1,984m above sea level, prepared to be captivated by the drama below of golden yellow birch trees, crisp greens pines and crimson red mountain ash.
  - **Lake Noto**: Come September, the whole lake is covered by the rich red of Glassworts. Under the crisp blue autumn sky, this vibrant red carpet stretches as far as the eye can see.
- Other places:** Sounkyo Gorge, Kamikawa Ice Pavilion

## Day 03

### Abashiri - Shiretoko

Hotel: *Shiretoko Grand Hotel (Hot spring) or similar (B / - / D)*

- **Okhotsk Drift Ice Museum**: Drift ice is symbolic of winter in the Okhotsk region. There is even a room kept at an unimaginable freezing temperature of -18 degrees all year round, where you can enjoy winter even in autumn.
  - **Shiretoko Five Lakes**: Looking like a god's handprint, these serene waters that mirror the spectacular autumn foliage of the Shiretoko mountain range create a paradise that weaves its magic on all its visitors.
- Other places:** Mt Tendo, Oshinkoshin Waterfalls.

## Day 04

### Shiretoko – Akan

Hotel: *Akan Tsuruga (Hot spring) or similar (B / - / D)*

- **Shiretoko Cruise**: One of the best ways to explore this wild untamed heart of Hokkaido. Named Shiretoko ("the end of the earth") by Hokkaido's indigenous people, the Ainu, this UNESCO World Heritage site is also home to Japan's biggest population of brown bears.

- **Lake Akan**: A beautiful crater in the Akan National Park, it is also home to one of Japan's National Special Natural Monument – marimo, a rare algae species that forms beautiful green balls. It can reach the size of a soccer ball only if left alone for a few centuries.

**Other places:** Mt Io, Lake Mashu, Ainu Kotan

## Day 5

### Akan - Tokachigawa

Hotel: *Tokachigawa Daiichi (Hot spring) or similar (B / - / D)*

- **Lake Onneto**: Every autumn, the coloured foliage of the trees vies with the gorgeous ever-changing colours of Lake Onneto's waters for which is the most breath-taking. Experience it first-hand and be the judge to decide the winner!
  - **Tokachigawa Butadon**: Try this Tokachigawa specialty – flame-grilled pork slices over fragrant rice, each tender and marinated lightly in a salty-sweet sauce unique to this region.
- Other places:** Lake Shikaribetsu, Ryugetsu Sweetpia Garden, Ikeda Wine Castle

## Day 6

### Tokachigawa - Sapporo

Hotel: *Sapporo Grand Hotel or similar (B / - / -)*

- **Sahoro Bear Mountain**: Home to 18 Hokkaido Brown bears. You can spot them splashing playfully in the water or dozing in the shade of the trees.
- **Chitose Salmon Park**: Every autumn, adult salmon from the Sea of Japan swim upstream along the Chitose River to spawn. Take the front row seat at this natural spectacle at the Underwater Observation Room here, where seven 8.5cm thick windows separate you from the jostling salmon.

## Day 7

### Sapporo

Hotel: *Sapporo Grand Hotel or similar (B / - / -)*

- **Otaru**: Once a flourishing seaport and the "Wall Street of the North", Otaru is where you will find lovingly restored warehouses that have become home to one of the biggest music box museums in the world, confectionary shops that bakes heavenly choux cream puffs and dessert and glass shops that sells exquisite glass wares.
  - **Sapporo**: Explore the heart of Hokkaido from an early morning visit to the Sapporo Curb Market for a spot of fresh seafood to a mouth-watering bowl of ramen late at night in Susukino's Ramen Alley.
- Other places:** Mitsui Outlet Park Kitahiroshima

## Day 8

Sapporo – Chitose – Tokyo – Singapore (B / - / -)

- Flight back to Singapore

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
